

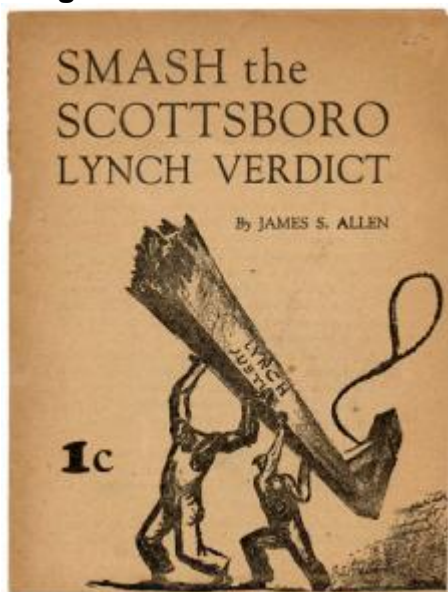
## James Allen on Scottsboro--"Smash The Scottsboro Lynch Verdict," published by Workers Library, April 1933.
